What are Indigo Children?

Who first talked about/discovered/identified them?

Nancy Anne Tappe www.nancyanntappe.com In her book 'Understanding Your Life Through Color' she writes about her colour system.

What are the Indigo Child traits?

7. They often see better ways of doing things, both at home and in school, which makes them seem like "system busters" (non-conforming to any system)

8. They seem antisocial unless they are with their own kind. If there are no others of like consciousness around them, they often turn inward, feeling like no other human understands them. School is often extremely difficult for them socially.

9. They will not respond to "guilt" discipline ("Wait till your father gets home and finds what you did")

10. They are not shy in letting you know what they need.

When were they born?

Nancy started noticing the life-purpose colour changing towards the end of the 1970's.

Are they still being born?

Yes, but not as many as during 1979-1999

<u>What is an Indigo Scout?</u>

Someone who 'looks out' for Indigos.

What is an Indigo Lightworker?

Someone who cares for, looks after, gave birth to, is interested in and 'lights the way' for the Indigos

What is an Indigo Adult?

Two answers:
